### OUTBOUND RELOCATION SERVICES

**Individual Outbound Relocation Assistance:** AFRC provides one-on-one relocation counseling/assistance to help you with your move. Moving can be an overwhelming experience and brings numerous questions, please let us help you step by step. Also be sure to check in with your AFRC at your new installation for Inbound Relocation Assistance programs.

**Child Care for PCS:** The Air Force Aid Society provides "Child Care for PCS" to members to assist with child care costs associated with a PCS move. Members may receive up to 20 hours of free child care per child in a licensed home day-care provider's home on base within 60 days of PCSing the base. Members must complete the required paperwork at the Airman and Family Readiness Center prior to using this program.

**Family Services Loan Closet:** The loan closet has a large selection of kitchen dishes, cookware, utensils and certain appliances for loan at no cost. Ironing boards and irons are also available for check out. These items can be loaned out for 30-day intervals. Let us assist you with your temporary household.
