The Family Child Care provides a variety of home child care services for active duty military personnel, DoD civilians, reservist on active duty, and DoD contractors.

The FCC program augments the Child Development and School Age programs. Providers are screened and monitored monthly by FCC staff. The Providers are authorized to keep a maximum of six children, including their own.

The FCC program accepts children for care who have chronic health problems, developmental delays, and children who are HIV-positive. Individuals with chronic health concerns, including those who are HIV-positive, may also be approved as FCC providers.

The Extended Duty Child Care (EDC) program is available for parents required to work mission related duty beyond the standard 50-hours work week.

NOTE: All homes are located on the East side unless annotated by W, N, S

Recruitment: The FCC office is recruiting providers to provide extended duty, shift, holidays, weekend hours and special needs.
